

Leadership Programme

- organise discos and mufti days

As well as their leadership roles throughout school life the leadership students follow a youth development programme called “Always a Leader” developed by the Halogen Foundation. Topics in this programme are:

- Who I am (self image)
- How I live (Integrity.
- Getting along with others (belonging)
- How I cope (self-confidence)
- The choices I make (responsibility and decision making)
- How I serve others (servant leadership)

Being an Avalon Intermediate School Leader comes with many responsibilities and rewards.

At the End of Year assembly a student is awarded the prestigious ‘Leadership Award’ which comes with a uniform scholarship to Taita College.
